



## Directions to Wacky Nut Farm from the North via Agate Pass Bridge

PLEASE NOTE: GPS navigation once on Bainbridge Island is very complicated and not direct. Suggest using directions below.



View of the entrance to Wacky Nut Farm on Rockaway Bluff Road. Barn is straight ahead and on the left and Guest House on the right.

- Drive to Poulsbo via Highway 3 either through Bremerton from Tacoma or over the Hood Canal bridge from points west. At Poulsbo take the Bainbridge Island exit onto Highway 305.
- Stay on Highway 305, over the Agate Pass bridge onto Bainbridge Island.
- Once on Bainbridge continue 3 – 4 miles to the second traffic light. Turn right onto Sportsman's Club Road and bear left at the Y. Continue straight through 2 four-way stops.
- Shortly after the second four-way there will be a Y intersection, turn left onto Finch Rd.
- Continue a short distance to a T-intersection. (You are coming up the stem of the T). At the stop sign turn right onto Wyatt Way
- At the bottom of the hill you will come to an intersection. DO NOT take road that bears left (to "Eagledale") but STAY on the road and bear right up a hill (becomes "Blakely").
- Continue on Blakely for about 3 ½ miles. Eventually you will see water on your right as the road goes down a hill and levels out at a five way stop. Go "straight" (it is slightly to the left) up Halls Hill Road (curvy hilly road). Stay on this road for about 1/3 mi. and look for the first PAVED road to the left - "Rockaway Bluff Rd". Turn left at this T-intersection.
- A cedar pole fence is on your right. Follow this fence until you come to the entrance to Wacky Nut Farm. (Big log gateposts!) Turn right into the driveway and then:

A -IF YOU ARE PULLING A TRAILER, TURN LEFT AT THE VERY FIRST POSSIBLE TURNING after you have entered the driveway - it angles left in front of the small grass turn paddock. Keeping the paddock on your right go between the indoor arena and the barn and turn right to unload in front of the barn. You should then park your trailer by backing it up to the arena. There will be someone there to greet you and help you in general.

B -IF YOU ARE IN A CAR, go straight ahead and park either in front of the stable or along the edge of the driveway. Someone will be there to greet you and help you park.
