As our boarders here at the farm already know, we will be closing the farm to non-essential personnel beginning Wednesday, March 25th. In following with Gov. Inslee's "Stay at Home" order, we feel that it is in the best interest for the care of the horses, **to only permit staff and trainers on-site at the farm for the next 14 days.** We will continue to monitor the situation on a daily basis, and will update you all with any new developments.
